On October 24, 2009 the Rockdale County High School Band will host the 32nd Annual Greater Atlanta Marching Festival. This event is a contest.

Band Classifications: Bands will be entered into classes based on the number of **wind** players of each performing group. Bands may enter in a higher class, but not a lower class. Silver Division is Classes A and AA. Gold Division is Classes AAA, AAAA, and Open.

- Class A – 1-40
- Class AA – 41-59
- Class AAA – 60-79
- Class AAAA – 80-100
- Open – 101 and up

Competition Ratings: Band ratings will follow GMEA recommended guidelines as follows:

Superior	85.0-100
Excellent	70.0-84.9
Good	55.0-69.9
Fair	0.0-54.9

Trophies: All bands receiving a Superior or Excellent rating will receive a trophy. Each frontline unit receiving a Superior will also receive a trophy. Additionally, the following trophies will be awarded:

- * 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place in Class for Bands and all frontline groups
- * Grand Champion Trophy for Band, Color Guard, and Percussion in each division.

Entry Fee/ Deadline: A \$75.00 fee per band is required for the event. All bands must include, by separate check, a \$500.00 performance bond. Performance bond checks will be held and returned upon band participation. **Entry forms and payments must be postmarked by October 9, 2009.** All bands are to register by mail - the order registrations are postmarked will determine the order of performance

1. Complete a Registration Form (including requisite signatures).
2. Submit two separate checks - one for the Registration fee and one for the performance bond.

Stadium description: Reid Memorial Stadium includes a six lane rubberized track. The first row of seats rests 8 feet above field level. The stadium runs 15 rows high with a 3 floor Press Box that sits 20 feet behind the last rows. There is an electrical outlet on the field for your use if necessary. Please note that our track has been newly refurbished, so track access is extremely limited.

Admissions: All directors and band staff are admitted free provided their names are included on the application form. Chaperones are admitted at a ratio of 1 for every 10 band students. Bus drivers are admitted free. All other supporters must pay the admission of \$8.00. This policy adheres to the guidelines of GMEA and GHSA.

Judging: The contest will be adjudicated by a panel of six

band judges (caption style) and one judge each for Color Guard, Percussion, Drum Major(s), and Drill Team/Majorettes. Please check our website (www.rockdaleband.com) for judging panel updates beginning in September.
